## Completion of Airborne Survey over Gardner Range Project

The Directors of Uranio Limited ("**Uranio**") (ASX: UNO) are pleased to announce that an airborne magnetic and radiometric survey at 100m spacing over areas of interest within Uranio Limited's Gardner Range Project was completed on time by UTS Geophysics on Friday, July 25.

The Gardner Range Project lies in the Tanami (eastern Kimberley) region of Western Australia, approximately 150km southeast of Halls Creek. This project is an unconformity related uranium and gold project and the project tenements cover both the Don and Deva uranium prospects and the Venus gold prospect.

The purpose of this survey was to carefully delineate the host structure near the unconformity at the Don prospect using airborne magnetics and to identify any further radiometric anomalies and similar potential host structures near the unconformity prior to a first pass drill program planned for later this year. Uranio has arranged for data analysis and interpretation by Southern Geoscience Consultants Pty Ltd, to be completed in the coming month.
