CLEM7 TRAFFIC VOLUMES – APRIL 2010

RiverCity Motorway Group today announced traffic volumes for April 2010 on the Clem Jones Tunnel (CLEM7).

The month included 5 days of toll-free travel from 1 to 5 April 2010. Tolls were in place from 6 to 30 April 2010. A 30% discount was applied to all tolls during this 25-day period.

Key points:

- Average Daily Trips of 21,178 during the tolled period is well below the start-up forecast of approximately 60,000 trips per day.
- Average Workday Trips increased by 6.2% since the first week of tolled traffic was released on 13 April 2010 (up from 21,977 to 23,348).
- The highest number of trips on a single workday during the month was 25,688 trips.
- Light Commercial Vehicles comprised 13% of vehicles that used the CLEM7 during the tolled period.
- The company will extend the current 30% discount on all tolls to 30 June 2010.
- The current toll-free period between midnight and 5:00am will cease at midnight on Sunday, 9 May 2010.
