EDMS experienced a year of contrasting halves in 2009/10, with an increase in work in the first half of the year over the previous six months. The second half of 2009/10, particularly the final quarter, was impacted heavily by the standby of a significant portion of the surface rig fleet due to regulatory delays and equipment breakdown.

Wet weather also played a part in revenue reduction in New South Wales in the final quarter of the 2009/10 financial year.

EDMS has recognised there are some inefficiencies in it's operations, and responded by the reorganisation of its operating entities, recruitment of key staff to implement and manage more robust processes and focusing strongly on cash management.

EDMS continues to focus on the importance of developing and maintaining a strong safety culture within our operations and across the group as whole.

#### **Financial Statements**

#### Revenue

The Group revenue for the full year was \$26.9million, an increase of 15.9 per cent on the corresponding period. The increase in revenue is attributable to the move into coal and gas exploration drilling, which has reduced the effects of the slower recovery of base metals caused by the global financial crisis in late 2008 and 2009.

Revenue contribution by Every Day Mine Services Operations Pty Ltd was hit hard by the slow base metals recovery with our drill rigs and labour services involved in this commodity sector suffering from inconsistent demand.

G.O.S. Drilling Pty Ltd and Australian Gas Drilling Pty Ltd experienced more consistent demand for its surface rigs in the first half of the year but significant wet weather and substantial standby on a number of projects impacted heavily on profitability in the second half of the year.

A number of rigs mobilised to a new contract, the Aston Resources - Maules Creek project, in the last days of the financial year, however this provided only a small contribution to the 2009/10 revenue, there is a strong expectation of an improved 2010/11 year.

#### Loss

Net loss after tax attributable to equity holders was \$(4.1) million. This represents a significant decrease from the prior year's result. After a promising first half performance, a combination of management issues, inclement weather, and project interruptions in the second half of year has not delivered as forecast. Delays in commissioning and putting in use new rigs has also contributed to the loss. Further contributing to the loss was a number of one off items including:

- A write off of \$1.384m of inventory
- A write off of \$0.197m for the Mine Mixers investment

#### Interest

Net interest expense increased to \$1.37 million from \$0.687 million in the prior year.

#### Cash flow and balance sheet

Cash from operations was \$(3.384) million, down from \$0.102 million in the prior period.

Capital expenditure totalled \$9.105 million for the year, compared to \$3.327 million in the prior period. The majority of this expenditure was incurred on new rigs and ancillary gear for use in the coal and energy sectors.

#### Mining outlook

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The mining services sector had been hit hard over the past 18 months. The outlook for the mining industry is optimistic with price rises in base metals and growth in China's demand for commodity imports such as coal, iron ore and copper.

Exploration and feasibility study projects in both coal and gas has increased significantly in both New South Wales and Queensland resulting in an increase in tendering and proposal activity in the latter part of the 2009/10 early part of the 2010/2011 financial years.

Recent recovery in the base metals mines also provides optimism for the underground services provided by the Company.

#### Strategy

A new executive management team has been assembled with a more strategic focus on the sustainable growth of the business and this team will place emphasis on improving the commercial outcomes of current and future contracts, implementing more robust systems and processes and increasing the return on assets.

In the short to medium term, the demand for surface rigs in coal and energy is likely to result in more optimal utilisation of the fleet. Consequently, EDMS will generate a greater proportion of its revenue from its surface fleet.

Whilst underground services are increasing month to month, the highly competitive nature of the underground drilling market has seen contract terms shorten and margins decrease.

EDMS will develop additional revenue streams by further development of its existing Labour Hire services as well as growing contract maintenance and servicing packages.

EDMS is confident of achieving a strong profit recovery in FY11 through efficiency gains, commercial and contractual improvements and a return on capital focus.

A strategic plan is currently under development and will be rolled out in the first quarter of the 2010/11 financial year.

#### Note 1. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies
