OUTCOME OF NON-RENOUNCEABLE ENTITLEMENT ISSUE

Directors of ATW Holdings Ltd ("Company" or "ATW") are pleased to announce the results of the non-renounceable pro-rata entitlement offer (**Offer**) announced to the market on 25 May 2012.

- 53 shareholders took up their entitlements and nearly half of those applied for some level of oversubscription.
- The total cash received was \$48,929.84.
- This left a shortfall (from the target of \$141,815) of \$92,885.16 (**Shortfall**).
- The Offer had been underwritten up to \$120,000 and the underwriter initially agreed to take up the full Shortfall.
- A sequence of unforseen adverse circumstances subsequently made it impossible for the underwriter to honour this commitment.
- Over the ensuing period the directors of ATW set about identifying suitable opportunities for the placement of the Shortfall, taking advantage of Exemption 3 under Listing Rule 7.2.
- Today ATW has concluded an agreement with Fitgenes Pty Ltd (**Fitgenes**) to place the entire Shortfall with Fitgenes. This placement is now being executed.

Directors are also pleased to announce that Fitgenes has completed its own capital raising and has re-confirmed its commitment to funding and finalising ATW's re-compliance with Chapters 1 and 2 of the Listing Rules.
