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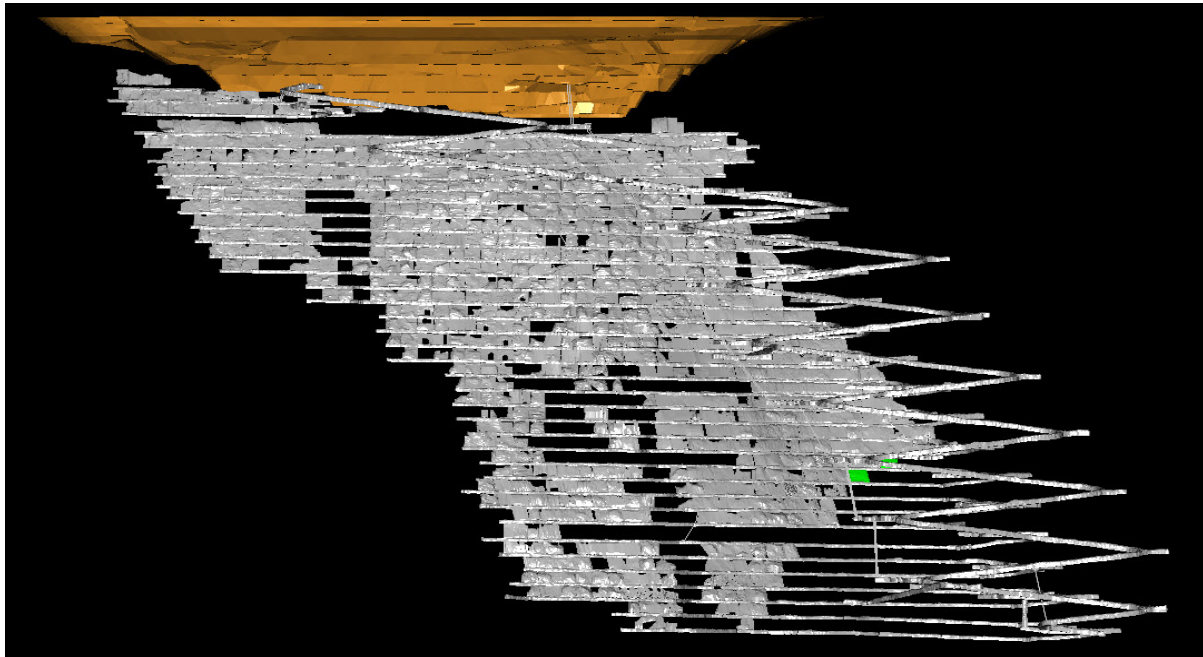
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Monthly Production Report for August 2014

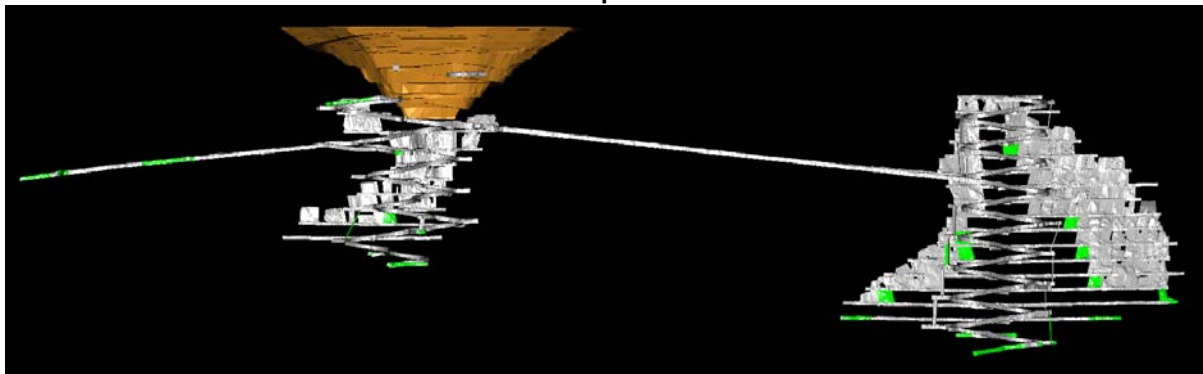
The production rate at Raleigh will increase as the new stoping front is established.
