AGRIMIN AND TJAMU TJAMU SIGN NEGOTIATION PROTOCOL

Highlights

- **Agrimin and the Kiwirrkurra people have agreed to negotiate in good faith with a view to entering into a Mining Agreement for the Mackay SOP Project**
- **Agrimin continues to receive strong community support and encouragement for the development of a potash operation**

Agrimin Limited (ASX: AMN) (“Agrimin” or “the Company”) is pleased to advise that it has signed a Negotiation Protocol with Tjamu Tjamu (Aboriginal Corporation) RNTBC, the Native Title representative body for the Kiwirrkurra people, for its 100% owned Mackay Sulphate of Potash (“SOP”) Project in Western Australia.

The protocol has been signed with a view to entering into a Mining Agreement for the development and operation of the Mackay SOP Project, whilst preserving the traditional way of life of the Kiwirrkurra people. The protocol contemplates a timeline for negotiations that is aligned with Agrimin’s overall indicative development timeline.

Mark Savich, CEO of Agrimin said “This is a significant milestone en route to forming a Mining Agreement. Over the past two years we have built a close working relationship with the Kiwirrkurra people. Through this relationship we are developing an understanding of the important issues that need to be managed alongside a future potash operation.”

Bobby West, Chairperson of Tjamu Tjamu (Aboriginal Corporation) RNTBC on behalf of the Kiwirrkurra people said “We have entered into this protocol for the Mackay SOP Project. We look forward to working with Agrimin to negotiate a mutually beneficial agreement that can create exciting opportunities for our community.”
