Spirits of Tasmania I and II provide the principal passenger and cargo shipping operation between the Australian Mainland and Tasmania.

This contract is significant in placing Aeeris and Early Warning Network at the forefront of maritime safety in Australia. We aggregate weather data from multiple sources to put on the smartphones carried by the ships' Masters the intelligence they need to maintain safety and increase efficiencies when both at sea and in port.

It reflects our leadership in understanding the complex hazards affecting enterprises today by producing bespoke solutions that reduce risk and maintain business through advanced knowledge of severe weather events.

Our tailored weather forecasting, monitoring and alerting services replace the need for mariners to search multiple websites to get an understanding of the level of hazard and risk to their operations. Our meteorologists review all relevant data sources from which to interpret and provide the right intelligence the ships' Masters need and put it directly on to their handheld devices.

The contract follows a three-month trial that demonstrated Aeeris and Early Warning Network could help TT-Line increase the protection of the two ships against the adverse weather that had previously disrupted the service between Devonport and Port Melbourne.

Commenting on the service, Captain Stuart Michael, General Manager Marine Operations for TT-Line and a former Master of the Spirits of Tasmania said,

"We have already seen the difference the advanced warnings provided by Aeeris and Early Warning Network make to passenger and crew safety. We anticipate the weather intelligence provided will help minimise disruption to our shipping operations."
