- **Two new prospecting licence applications adjoining its existing Dalgara Project area**
- **Foot print at the Dalgara Project to increase by 300% upon grant of the prospecting licences**

Krakatoa Resources Ltd (“Krakatoa” or “the Company”, ASX: **KTA**) is pleased to announce that the Company has completed two new prospecting licence applications (P59/2140 and P59/2141) for ground adjoining the existing Dalgara Project (P59/2082) – refer to Figure 1.

The two prospecting licence applications cover a total area of 322 hectares and if granted, will expand Krakatoa’s foot print at the Dalgara Project by 300% to 430 hectares.

Krakatoa made direct application to the Department of Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety for the additional licences and is confident of the grant of the new prospecting licences based on discussions with its tenement advisers.

A program of geological mapping and collation of all available historical exploration data on the newly acquired project area will commence in due course following confirmation of the grant of the new prospecting licences.


