1. Introduction

The ASX provides an independent terminal interface for market participants to access the New Trading Platform for Futures and Cash markets. This terminal is designed to help in enabling greater efficiency for access to the markets.

ASX Terminal contains the following:

- Global protocols that enable customers to reduce their development, connectivity and maintenance costs
- Modular design that improves flexibility and implementation time enabling ASX to reduce development costs and deliver new products and services to market quicker
- Multi-currency capabilities that enable ASX to trade and deposit instruments in the main currencies relevant to Australia's financial markets
- New market monitoring and risk management systems that ensure the high quality of Australia's financial markets are maintained.

Note:

To install ASX Terminal, a user name and password is required. This is used to access ASX Online where the ASX Terminal file can be downloaded. Existing user names and password for ASX Online can be used. To obtain a new user name and password contact CST.

2. Supported Environment

ASX Terminal requires the following environment:

- Operating System – Windows
- Version – 7 or higher
- Hardware – X86 64 bit
- JRE Requirements – Oracle Java 8u60
- System – Win64.



Note:

ASX Terminal is not available over a Virtual Private Network (VPN).

3. Installation

To install ASX Terminal:

1. Click [Oracle](#).

This opens the Oracle website where the Java Runtime Environment (JRE) can be downloaded.

2. Click **JRE>DOWNLOAD**.



3. Click **Accept License Agreement**.

Once the license agreement has been accepted the license can be downloaded.

Java SE Runtime Environment 8 Downloads

Do you want to run Java™ programs, or do you want to develop Java programs, but not develop them, download the Java Runtime Environment 8.

If you want to develop applications for Java, download the Java Development Kit 8. The JDK includes the JRE, so you do not have to download both separately.

4. Select **Windows x64 .exe** download. (Version 8u60 is the current version when writing this document however the latest version available is acceptable)

7. Enter the ASX Online user name and password in the corresponding fields.
8. Download the ASX_Terminal ZIP file.
9. Extract the contents of the ZIP file.
10. Run "asxterminal.exe" from the extracted file set.
