SPEAKER AND PANEL MEMBER BIOGRAPHIES

Justin Nelson

Justin joined the ASX in March 2000 and has been State Manager, SA and Manager Issuers (Adelaide) since 2004. Prior to joining the ASX Justin worked as a legal practitioner, predominately in the area of insurance law and commercial dispute resolution. The focus of Justin's current role is on the real time monitoring of ASX listed companies' continuous disclosure, with the primary objective being to ensure ASX meets its licence requirements and provides a fair, orderly and transparent market.

Peter Stoker

Peter is a Principal Geologist with AMC consultants Pty Ltd with 40 years experience in mine geology, mineral resource and ore reserve estimation, feasibility studies, project evaluation and mineral exploration.

Peter is a Fellow of The Australasian Institute of Mining and Metallurgy (AusIMM) and a Chartered Professional (Geology). He is the current Chairman of the Joint Ore Reserves Committee and was Secretary from late 1999 to 2005. He is also a member of Committee for Mineral Reserves International Reporting Standards (CRIRSCO). He was a member of the Steering Committee and a contributor for Monograph 23 "Mineral Resources and Ore Reserves Estimation - The AusIMM Guide to Good Practice" and has authored or co-authored a number of papers on Mineral Resource and Ore Reserve estimation, classification, exploration research and practice.

David Pollard

David is a metallurgist who is a fellow of AusIMM, Chair of the Adelaide Branch of AusIMM and Chair of AusIMM Metallurgical Society.

David was Education Manager, Australian Mineral Foundation from 1988 – 2000, which involved developing and managing short courses for professionals in the minerals and petroleum industries, with outreach to the finance sector, legal sector and senior company management.

Currently a David is a consultant with a focus on professional development for minerals industry professionals and is the convener of AusIMM MetPlant conference series, and organiser of advanced level interactive workshops. When David joined the Australian Mineral Foundation as Education Manager in 1988, his first project was to manage a series of seminar presentations on behalf of AusIMM, AIG and ASX in the capital cities to introduce the JORC Code.

RJ (Bob) Gunthorpe

B Sc (Hons), 1965, and Ph D, 1971, University of New England, Armidale, MBA, University of Cape Town, 1985, Member, Australasian Institute of Mining and Metallurgy, (AusIMM), Member of Joint Ore Reserves Committee (JORC) for 10 years (1993 to 2003), representing the Minerals Council of Australia.

Bob is currently a geological consultant based in Adelaide, employed by Adelaide Resources Ltd and Buka Gold Ltd on ongoing basis. From 1988 to 2002 Bob was with Normandy Mining Ltd, progressing to Group Chief Geologist, Exploration Division. From 1976 to end 1987 Bob worked for Tsumeb Corporation Limited, Tsumeb, Namibia, progressing to Chief Geologist-Exploration.

Stefan Pfeifle

Stefan Pfeifle is a senior lawyer in the Emerging Mining & Resources team and is based in Perth. Stefan qualified as a lawyer in South Africa and worked at Freehills in Perth as a lawyer for 3 years before joining ASIC in 1991.

As part of his work, Stefan reviews, amongst others, fund-raising documents and takeover documents as well as dealing with applications for relief from the Corporations Act in these and financial reporting areas.

Dr A. John Parker *BSc (Hons), PhD, Dipl Comp Sc*

Dr Parker is managing director of Lincoln Minerals Limited and is a geologist and geophysicist with extensive knowledge of mineral deposits and mineralizing systems in the Gawler Craton. He was formerly Chief Geologist with the mapping branch of the SA Geological Survey with whom he worked for over 20 years and has mapped extensively throughout the Gawler Craton and, in particular, on Eyre Peninsula.

Dr Parker has over 15 years experience in mineral exploration initially as a consultant geologist and director of Geosurveys Australia Pty Ltd but more recently as Managing Director of Lincoln Minerals Limited. He has made a major contribution to the identification and delineation of iron ore resources on Eyre Peninsula and has contributed to the discovery and enhancement of various other mineral deposits within South Australia. He has prepared independent geological reports for inclusion in mineral industry IPOs.

He is a former Fulbright Postdoctoral Fellow during which time he worked on Lake Superior iron ores, has been a member of the Geological Society of Australia and Australian Society of Exploration Geophysicists for over 30 years and is Vice Chairman, SA Branch, of the Australian Institute of Geoscientists.
