## **Update to SYCOM Trading Halt 9/12/99**

The Exchange's developers provided a fix on the weekend of 11 December which has been successfully tested and implemented.

## **NZFOE TRADING HALT - 13/12/99**

Members are advised that the New Zealand market was halted for a period of 13 minutes due to a core hardware failure.

As part of the normal recovery process, the Exchange cut over to its backup system where trading was resumed at 6.42am (Sydney time).

The Exchange is in the process of replacing the faulty hardware.
