Dear Shareholders,

Welcome to TSV Holdings Shareholder Newsletter. As a company we plan to communicate regularly with shareholders, customers and suppliers though the release of a regular newsletter. TSV Holdings currently have three divisions, Austco a manufacturer of Healthcare Communications products, Calltec which sells, installs and services the Austco product range and Tecsound, which specialises in communication products for quick service restaurant and retail national clients.

I am pleased to report on the market enthusiasm and initial strong sales growth of our Third Generation IP Nurse call systems which we have been developing for the last four years. The marketing and sales launch of CallCare IP commenced in April where we invited all our senior international managers to Perth to plan the international release, followed a week later by the official Australian launch to our national resellers. This event, over three days, was enthusiastically received by all our resellers who were already aware of the successful deployment of CallCare IP with selected clients last year. The level of enthusiasm surrounding CallCare IP is well warranted as this development firmly places Austco as the market leader worldwide in IP Nurse Call System solutions in both the Hospital and Aged Care Markets.

MARKETING DEVELOPMENTS

North America

The Austco team in North America has just received an order for the supply and commissioning of the complete MediCom SC nurse call system for the Sault Area Hospital.

The new 289 bed Sault Area Hospital represents the largest construction project in the history of the Algoma District in Ontario Canada.

This project follows on from the success in completing the much larger 600 plus bed William

Osler Health Center - Brampton Civic Hospital project in Brampton Ontario, where we partnered with Siemens to provide the MediCom nurse call, infant security and RFID asset tracking systems.

The Sault Area Hospital project was partnered with Honeywell and they issued a purchase order for \$425K to Austco in March 2008. Austco's Canadian team dealt closely with Jeff Mumford, Honeywell's Ontario and Atlantic General Manager, on how Austco and Honeywell could work together in the Acute Care market. These meetings led to a strategic partnership between Honeywell and Austco. Austco is now involved in all the Acute Care projects that Honeywell has taken an interest in across Canada. The relationship has solidified even further with Honeywell requesting strategic reseller status and having Austco and our healthcare products listed in Honeywell's Global Commodity Group as a preferred vendor.

New Zealand



On April 10 and 12 the NZ Council of Christian Social Services Biennial Conference and Trade Exhibition was held in Napier. The theme was "Justice & Compassion in Action". Austco had many long term customers among the delegates and it was a chance to reinforce the message that we are a reliable partner amongst our existing and potential new customers in the Aged Care market.
