Appointment of Project Manager

As previously announced, King Island Scheelite Limited (**ASX:KIS**) and Hunan Non-Ferrous Metals Corporation formed the Dolphin Joint Venture (DJV) for the purpose of developing the King Island scheelite mine.

The DJV has today appointed Lindsay Newnham as the DJV Project Manager, effective 1 January 2009. Lindsay is an experienced geologist and project manager who, since 1990, has worked as a consultant to the mining industry.

Lindsay has particular expertise with Tasmanian mining projects, having most recently managed exploration and development activities for Allegiance Mining NL (Allegiance). He was Project Manager for the underground assessment of the Avebury nickel sulphide deposit developed by Allegiance.

Prior to becoming a consultant in 1990, Lindsay was Exploration Manager for RGC Exploration Pty Ltd. Over the past 35 years, Lindsay has played a major role in discoveries such as Henty Gold (Tasmania), Lucky Draw (NSW) as well as in the extension of life for Mt. Lyell. Lindsay was Project Manager at the Beaconsfield mine and at the development and construction of the Anchor (tin) mine, Tasmania.

KIS Chairman, Tony Haggarty, said "Lindsay Newnham is an experienced geologist and Project Manager whose background is particularly relevant to the DJV. Since the 1960's, his work has included the successful development of various mining exploration projects within Tasmania. We welcome Lindsay's appointment as the DJV Project Manager."
