APPEAL OF FINE FOR BREACH OF MINING MANAGEMENT ACT (NT)

TopTung Limited (**TopTung**) (**Company**) (ASX: **TTW**) advised on 14 October 2015 that it had appealed the decision of the Court of Summary Jurisdiction in the Northern Territory in relation to fine levied for breaching section 35(4) of the Mining Management Act (NT).

On 22 October 2015, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Northern Territory delivered his decision to reduce the fine from \$300,000 to \$150,000 on the basis that the original ruling was manifestly excessive.

Given the appeal was successful, the Company will make an application to the court for a partial recovery of costs regarding the appeal proceedings and will update the market in due course.

The Company is considering if it will further appeal this latest decision by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Northern Territory.
