G8 COMMUNICATIONS LIMITED ("G8") EXPANDS MARKET OPPORTUNITIES WITH SHIPMENT OF PRODUCT TO THE STATE OF NEBRASKA

- The State of Nebraska has contracted with G8's 100% wholly owned subsidiary Connected IO to purchase devices over the next 3 years.
- The units are to provide 4g streaming video on municipal snow plows through out the state of Nebraska.
- While the anticipated revenue from the current relationship is modest and estimated to be approximately \$150,000, the opportunity to move into a new market segment is significant.
- The addressable market in USA and Canadian municipalities has potential for over 50,000 snow plows.

G8 Communciations Limited ("G8") is pleased to announce that is has executed an agreement to provide its Lt1000 modem to the State of Nebraska to be integrated into snow plows to provide 4g streaming video. The agreement is for the provision of up to 650 units over 3 years and the first batch of 215 units is expected to be shipped this week.

The agreement with the State of Nebraska illustrates the growing awareness of G8's products and continues its expansion into a variety of sectors not otherwise identified. The municipal snow plow potential market in the USA and Canada represents approximately 50,000 vehicles, however the potential for the Company's products to be utilised in other municipal vehicles generally represents a much larger opportunity.











The Company continues to progress its large distribution opportunities with major telecommunications groups and anticipates providing further updates to the market in coming weeks.
