Intelligent Cardiovascular Information System (iCVIS) launched at Sunshine Coast University Hospital

Highlights:

- **First installation of iCVIS in QLD, integrated with the Queensland Health Hospital-Based Corporate Information System.**
- **Strengthening of the commercialisation of iCVIS through FUJIFILM.**
