QUARTERLY ACTIVITIES REPORT

OVERVIEW

During the quarter the Company reviewed a number of potential investment opportunities outside of listed equities. These discussions are still early stage and further updates will be provided to the market should they progress further.

As previously announced the Company continues to work with Cloud Lumen LLC towards their proposed Initial Public Offer ("IPO") on the Australian Securities Exchange ("ASX"). The Company expects Cloud Lumen will seek listing in the 4th quarter of 2017.

On 30 June 2017, Citation Resources Ltd ("CTR") held its Extraordinary General Meeting ("EGM") to consider a number of resolutions including change of activities and the acquisition of Pearl Global Pty Ltd. All resolutions were successfully carried at the EGM. FGF is a noteholder in Pearl Global Pty Ltd and the notes are expected to convert into equity in CTR (to be renamed Pearl Global Limited) following recent Prospectus offer and all relevant ASX approvals being granted. Pearl Global Limited is expected to recommence trading in 3rd quarter of 2017.

As at the end of the quarter, the Company held:

- i. Approximately \$840,325 in cash and receivables; and
- ii. \$1,230,000 in listed securities and convertible notes;
