WANGLE ATTENDS CYBER SAFETY TRAINING WITH AUSTRALIAN FEDERAL POLICE

The ThinkUKnow program aims to deliver accessible cyber safety education through a unique partnership between law enforcement and industry, with information designed to encourage parents and carers to communicate openly with young people about their online habits. Law enforcement representatives presented case studies on a range of topics including cyberbullying and online grooming, and discussed the preventative measures required to reduce the number of incidents affecting young Australians.

In addition, the Office of eSafety presented resources and tools on offer for victims of cyberbullying and Image Based Abuse, detailed their close work with social media platforms to help action reported cases of cyberbullying, and presented the education content they provide for all Australians on cyber safety issues.

The programs reinforce the education-driven approach of the Company's parental control platform Wangle Family Insites (**WFI**) which combines cutting edge technology with educational resources designed to strengthen relationships between parents and children, and to help families safely navigate the internet.

Wangle CEO Mr Sean Smith said:
