Operations Update

Pearl Global Limited (Pearl) (ASX:PG1), a newly listed, revolutionary tyre processing company that is advancing rapidly towards commercial scale production, is pleased to advise the following update.

Pearl has reported excellent progress on the commissioning of its first commercial scale production facility, in Stapylton, Queensland. The site is now in the final stages of the commissioning process. The commissioning process is not limited to the Thermal Desorption Units, but all operational functions.

New Thermal Oxidiser received and commissioned

Pearl has invested in a new thermal oxidiser that will further enhance its capacity for production and pollution control. Pearl's new thermal oxidiser, custom built specifically for Pearl operations, is a unit for air pollution control that incinerates hazardous gases at temperatures of up to 1300°C, making them suitable for release into the atmosphere.

Managing Director Mr Andrew Drennan, said "we are very pleased with this new investment along with the positive results from independent testing by Haztek of our operating environment. We are making good progress and based on this, we expect to complete our full operation commissioning program in the coming weeks."

Independent Occupational Health Exposure Report - Haztek Pty Limited

As part of site commissioning, Pearl has completed an independent audit from HAZTEK Pty Limited on the occupational health exposure whilst the site was operational. Haztek certified occupational hygienists assessed amongst other elements, exposure limits to shredded tyre dust, carbon black, occupational noise, Polycyclic Aromatic Hydrocarbons (PAH's), volatile organic compounds and gases such as carbon monoxide and hydrogen sulphide.

Pearl is pleased to report that the report confirmed a healthy and safe working environment for site operators and employees. Executive Chairperson Gary Foster said that "we are pleased to receive confirmation of our safe working environment which reinforces that our systems and processes for processing end-of-life tyres is robust and world class."

Pearl looks forward to keeping the market updated on its activities.
