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WANGLE ENTERS AGREEMENT WITH PARENT COMMUNICATIONS PLATFORM SKOOLBAG

Wangle Technologies Limited (Wangle or the Company) (ASX:WGL) is pleased to announce it has entered into an Affiliate Heads of Agreement with **SkoolBag (a subsidiary of ASX listed entity MOQ Limited)** in support of its child protection software, **Wangle Family Insites (WFI)**.

SkoolBag is Australia's leading school communication platform, used by over 2,700 primary and secondary schools nationally to update over 1 million parents.
