

SCEE awarded Kemerton lithium plant project

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Highlights

• SCEE awarded approximately \$65m of E&I works at Kemerton lithium processing plant

Southern Cross Electrical Engineering Limited ("SCEE") is pleased to announce that it has been awarded the Electrical and Instrumentation works at the MARBL Lithium Joint Venture's new Kemerton lithium hydroxide processing plant near Bunbury, Western Australia.

Albemarle Corporation, which owns 60% of the MARBL Lithium Joint Venture, is a leading US specialty chemicals company that owns 49% of the Talison lithium mine at Greenbushes, Western Australia, which supplies a significant part of global lithium production in the form of high quality spodumene. As part of the MARBL Lithium Joint Venture, Albemarle also owns 60% of the Wodgina lithium mine in Western Australia. The Kemerton processing plant will initially comprise of two trains, each with a production capacity of 25,000 tons of lithium hydroxide per annum.

The award for SCEE is to deliver the full E&I scope for both the Hydromet and Pyromet sections of the plant with an approximate value of \$65 million. SCEE's work is due to commence around the end of the first quarter of 2020 and is due for completion in May 2021.
