Further to the Company's disclosure at its 2019 full year results presentation, Citadel is pleased to announce that the Department of Defence has elected to exercise both its extension options, taking the Company's support contract through to July 2021.

In the near future, Citadel expects the Department of Defence to issue the anticipated new tender or similar process for the longer-term sustainment contract, a process in which Citadel will participate.

Citadel's CEO, Mark McConnell, said: "We are very pleased to be awarded the two contract extensions by the Department of Defence, reflecting the quality work that Citadel has delivered to the Department over many years.

This news comes on the back of other recent material contract extensions, including the 10-year contract extension for Enterprise Pathology Software for Queensland Health announced on 13 December 2019."

Citadel's subsidiary Kapish Services Pty Ltd (**Kapish**) specialises in the installation, delivery and support of the Micro Focus Content Manager record management system. To deepen its capability in this area, Kapish has now completed the acquisition of the business and assets of Linked Training Pty Ltd (**Linked**).

Linked's focus is the delivery (both in person and remotely through a popular cloud eLearning platform) of training to end users and administrators on the use of Content Manager. Although not a material acquisition in the context of Citadel's M&A strategy, the incorporation of Linked's training capabilities increases the depth of Kapish's training services for all its Content Manager customers.

Following the announcement at the 2019 AGM of Citadel's preferred supplier status to manage and support the Melbourne Genomics Alliance (**Genovic**) systems, Citadel confirms that it has now moved to a full contract valued at approximately \$500,000 for the initial

stages of Genovic's work, with options to extend for a further 3 years following further client funding approval.

Genovic is an alliance of 10 leading healthcare and research organisations, committed to improving patient outcomes via the rapid identification of cancer and disease symptoms. Citadel Health will initially be responsible for managing the Genovic platform, help desk, application and integration testing, change management and client onboarding. Genovic is a global pioneer in this space, and Citadel is confident that the early success of the program validates the global and scalable nature of this opportunity.
