\$1m Government Customer Repeat Order

DroneShield Ltd (ASX:DRO) ("DroneShield" or the "Company") is pleased to announce it has received an order in total amount of approximately \$1 million from a high profile Government customer from a Five Eyes country.

The order, placed by an existing customer, is a substantial increase from the initial trial purchase of approximately \$500,000 made last year, where payment was received in the June 2020 quarter. Additional follow up orders are currently being discussed, with the amounts to be confirmed.

Oleg Vornik, DroneShield's CEO, commented, "We are pleased to continue to support and strengthen our partnership with this customer, who has some of the most demanding requirements globally. This significantly larger follow-on order is a testament to both the industry leading capabilities of DroneShield products and an example of a common procurement pattern in our industry, where an initial order and evaluation might take some time, but once the solution has been validated and thoroughly vetted by the end user, larger follow-on orders result. We look forward to building on this and continuing to work with customers throughout the Five Eyes government customers."

The payment for the order, which is considered material by DroneShield, is expected to be received in full in the June 2021 quarter.
