O1 Welcome and committee overview



01 – ClearStar Program Committee

The ClearStar Program Committee acts as a stakeholder forum for consultation and input on projects to replace and transform the systems and technology that underpin ASX derivatives clearing services (ClearStar Program).

Responsibilities

- Be a key forum for ASX to communicate and consult with clearing participants, trading participants, their software providers and other relevant stakeholders.
- Members are expected to provide input, advice and expertise for consideration by ASX Management and relevant ASX Boards.
- Provide a forum for escalation of matters considered by other ASX stakeholder forums in relation to the ClearStar Program.

Key Topics

- Program status update, including:
 - project activities e.g. readiness, cutover, migration and attestation;
 - industry testing phases and approach (scope of testing, ASX and industry roles); and
 - implementation timeline.
- Consultation and working group updates.
- Member topics raised ahead of the committee, with the ASX secretariat (via the ClearStar mailbox <u>ASXClearStar@asx.com.au</u>) or bilaterally.

Logistics

- Meetings will leverage Microsoft Teams and will be in-person and virtual.
- Meetings will be up to 2 hours and held quarterly unless the Chair, with member support, determines more than four meetings a year are required.
- Draft agendas and presentation material are circulated one week prior to the committee.
- All meetings are minuted and will be circulated with members and signed by the chair to ensure they are a true and correct record.
- Comments will not be attributed to a specific member representative for any written minutes or reports prepared.



02 – Committee charter

Summary

- On 16 May ASX published the ClearStar Program Committee Charter.
 The charter outlines:
 - an overview of the purpose and logistics of the committee; and
 - responsibilities of ASX, committee members, and the committee chair.
- The Charter was published on a new area of the ClearStar Program website that includes details on the Committee including:
 - meeting details on past and upcoming meetings; and
 - after each committee:
 - agendas and presentation material; and
 - committee approved minutes.

02 – Committee composition

- ASX will provide secretariat, facilities and services.
- A member of ASX Management will be nominated to attend and report to, and from, ASX Management and the relevant ASX Board.
- A chair is appointed by members for a period of one year or such other period as determined by the committee.
- The role of the chair is to:
 - convene, set the agenda for, and preside over meetings;
 - facilitate discussion and forge a consensus;
 - finalise and sign the minutes of meetings;
 - provide input to ASX Management to facilitate their reporting to, and from, ASX Management and the relevant ASX Board; and
 - where requested, attend a meeting of the relevant ASX Board considering a report and provide input on matters the subject of the report.






02 – Committee chair

- ASX is seeking committee chair nominations by 9 July.
- Where required, nominations will be taken to an anonymised member vote with the result announced on 30 July.

OTC Calypso Upgrade Project

- ASX upgraded to Calypso (v18), along with internal infrastructure refreshes
- The upgrade represented a like-for-like change in terms of stakeholder interaction with services
- The Calypso version 18 upgrade will better position ASX's OTC Clearing Platform for future improvements, including customer requested changes and product enhancements
- No interface or file format changes for participants
- Delivered as of 26 May 2025



ETD TradeAccept Replacement Project

- ASX replacing TradeAccept, offering off-market trade reporting for exchange traded futures
- Enhanced UI dashboard and simplified trade entry with upfront validation
- UI Usability Demonstration completed May 2025
- FIX Interface to support all trade types allowing integration to participant systems, draft specifications published 30 May 2025
- ASX consultation response paper on solution, implementation approach and proposed go-live timeframes published 10 June 2025
- Prototype demonstration scheduled for Q4 CY2025
- ASX 24 operating rules and procedures consultation for Q4 CY2025
- Industry wide testing scheduled for Q1 Q2 CY2026
- Targeted go-live Q2 CY2026.




ETD Futures Clearing Replacement Project

- ASX replacing the existing Genium clearing system with Nasdaq Real Time Clearing (NRTC)
- Strategic solution to further automate processes
- Better visibility on workflow
- New features such as 4 eye check
- Future roadmap to move ETO clearing onto NRTC
- ASX are currently in a planning phase and will be further consulting with participants to ensure industry has input into the solution design and project timelines
- Consultation paper outlining solution and proposed go-live timeframes due out shortly. Responses due August 2025
- Subject to consultation, targeted go-live H2 CY2026

Industry support for the project to **modernise** and enhance trade reporting infrastructure



Strong support for design and functional scope, including the UI, workflows, history and dual sided trade flow



Strong support for technical scope, including access channels and user access



Strong support for **go- live schedule,** noting a preference to avoid roll months and holiday periods



Strong support for implementation approach



Varied responses on user access report and multi-factor authentication options



Support for attribute rationalisation, noting some ongoing concerns of operational complexity of physical leg reporting

Summary


- While ASX has set out its proposal on how it intends to deliver the ETD TradeAccept system replacement, ASX will continue to engage
 with stakeholders through the ClearStar Program Committee, supporting working groups, the ASX website and targeted bilateral
 engagement.
- Possible future enhancements are subject to additional analysis and market support and are not planned for the initial release.
- In addition to publishing draft FIX messaging specifications and sample messages 30 May 2025, ASX will provide comprehensive project and technical documentation. ASX aims to provide relevant documentation at least three months prior to the commencement of industry wide testing.
- ASX 24 Operating Rules and Procedures consultation related to TradeAccept system replacement changes is targeting Q4 CY2025.

05 - ETD Futures Clearing Replacement consultation paper

Summary

- The consultation paper has been informed by industry engagement to date and outlines ASX's proposed approach to the ETD Futures Clearing Replacement Project. Its purpose is to share further information and obtain feedback on the proposed approach.
- The consultation paper will provide details of the design, approach and proposed timelines of the system replacement, specifically:
 - key business concepts, workflows and processes;
 - user and participant configuration management including access, roles, groups, authentication management, browser support and access review;
 - User Interface (UI), including the sample screens and details surrounding key functions;
 - system to system interface (FIX interface), noting detailed FIX specifications have a planned Q3 CY2025 release;
 - o implementation approach, proposed activity timelines and planned documentation; and
 - next steps and matters for further consideration.
- Responses are due six weeks after publication, via one of the following methods:
 - o an editable Excel spreadsheet listing all questions provided by ASX and completed by responding organisations. Submitted as an attachment to asxclearstar@asx.com.au;
 - email to <u>asxclearstar@asx.com.au</u> in a format suitable to responding organisations.
- ASX is targeting a response to feedback in Q3 CY2025, noting a separate consultation on ASX Clear (Futures) Operating Rules will be
 published, if required, outlining any changes because of the system replacement.
