User access

- · ASXOnline.com via public internet
- Multifactor authentication (MFA)
- ASX assisted initial user migration
- Self-service for enterprise admins
- 4hr sessions, 15m idle auto-logout
- · Supports setup of user groups



FIX Connectivity

- FIX protocol (5.0 SP2)
- Covers bilateral and third-party trade submission
- Supports dual-sided reporting
- Standard Trade Capture <AE> and <AR> messages
- FIX messaging specifications <u>via the</u> <u>ClearStar webpage</u>



User roles

- Flexibility to attribute different roles to users within their organisation
- Including admin, user, viewer, authoriser and approver roles



Notifications

- Display temporary alerts to confirm successful actions
- Dashboard which automatically refreshes with new trades and changes in trade status
- Email notifications for activity requiring action. For security purposes, these will **not** contain embedded links






ETD TradeAccept Replacement

User access and roles

- ASXOnline.com
- Multifactor authentication (MFA) with member gateway to be announced
- Supports user roles including viewer, operator and manager
- Resource group assigned by a predefined hierarchy within the system



Execution source code / tag 1031

- ASX understands the importance of 'tag 1031' for efficient billing and brokerage purposes and plan to make it available to update as part of the clearing process
- Once available as part of the ASX 24 replacement, the clearing solution will consume this information directly from trading



New member gateway

- Transition required from OM Net API gateway to the new REST API with FIXML & JSON messaging
- · Connectivity via ASX Net
- DRAFT specifications <u>via the</u> <u>ClearStar webpage</u>



Reporting

- Improvements given the new clearing platform is event-based with more standardised workflows
- Simplified futures transactions and positions reporting
- Discontinue offering an on-exchange brokerage settlement service



Industry support for the project to modernise and enhance functionality and infrastructure

Strong support for design and functional scope, including average pricing and more a more continuous clearing capability

Strong support for technical scope, including browser-based UI and proposed user roles and user authorisation model

Key response themes







Strong support for expanded Member Gateway, contingent on clear API specifications and availability of adequate testing windows

Conditionally supportive feedback for proposed enhancements to existing reporting, subject to additional details

Participant/vendor work required to implement reporting changes. Strong preference for reporting in csv format (machinereadable)









Feedback window closed 25 August 2025 Response paper release 7 October 2025

Consultation paper released 14 July 2025

Many respondents would like additional fields added to Atlantis feed and support for retiring onexchange brokerage settlement

Support for **implementation** approach, noting importance of sufficient lead time and early access to test environments

Support for **go-live schedule**, noting a preference to avoid roll months and holiday periods

Next Steps

- The ETD Futures Clearing Replacement Consultation Response Paper was released October 7.
- ASX will continue to engage with stakeholders through the ClearStar Program Committee, supporting working groups, the ASX website and targeted bilateral engagement.
- Possible future enhancements are subject to additional analysis and market support and are not planned for the initial release.
- In addition to publishing draft Member Gateway specifications and sample messages on 5 August 2025, ASX will provide comprehensive project and technical documentation. ASX aims to provide relevant documentation at least three months prior to the commencement of industry wide testing.
- Futures Clearing Operating Rules and Procedures consultation related to system replacement changes is targeting mid-2026.

Discovery and Planning Phase

- As part of the ClearStar Program, ASX intends to replace the ETO Clearing Platform (Derivatives Clearing System (DCS)) and ASX FlexClear.

 - modernise the ETO derivatives clearing service;
 - improve efficiencies;
 - enhance customer experience; and
 - align to industry standards and best practice.




