Summary	Release Notes

As part of ITE open for Release 1, the Trading and Clearing functions within CHESS have been replaced by new Clearing services functionality.

The Release 1 ITE provides AMOs or their Software Providers a secure, standardised channel to report trades and prices for Clearing and Settlement.

1. Available functionality

FIX Channel	<p>A new industry standard FIX channel has been implemented allowing a standardised interface for all AMOs to report trades and market data to CHESS ('BaNCs').</p> <p>AMOs will have the option to establish multiple FIX sessions (via CompID).</p>	<p>AMOs can manage their FIX session with the following supported session layer messages, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Logon (A) • Logout (5) • Heartbeat (0) • TestRequest (1) • ResendRequest (2) • SequenceReset (4) <p>See the AMO User Technical Documentation (from Stakeholder Engagement) for more details on these messages and their usage.</p> <p>ASX request AMOs or their Software Providers limit transmission of messages to 5000 per business day at a maximum of 50 trades per second throughput, while the channel is being productionised, and is undergoing further performance and resiliency testing.</p>

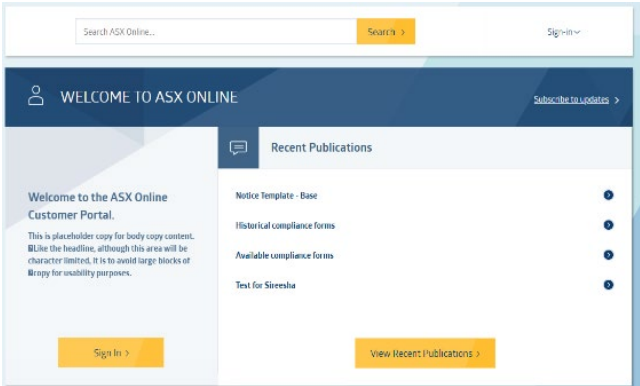
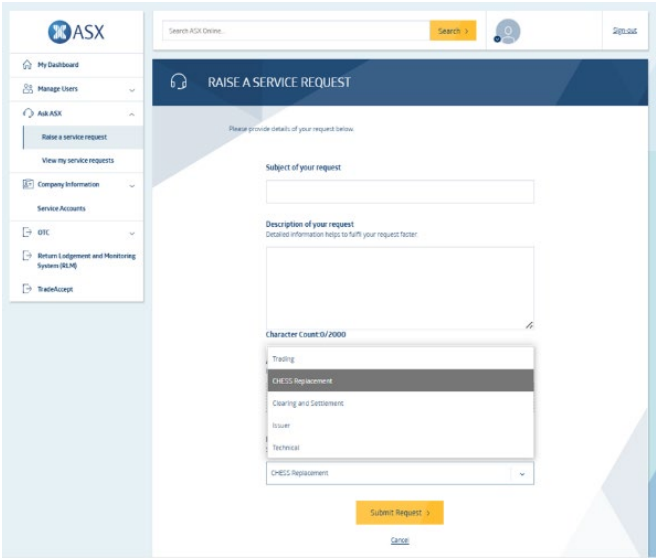
Data object	Description	Release notes
System Actors (Entities, Actors and Roles)	Creation and management of entities, actors and roles in the system to define how a Participant can transact in the system.	These functions are managed by ASX Operational Staff and therefore there are no external facing functional specifications.
