

CHESS Release 1 Cutover Runbook now available

We are pleased to advise that the **CHESS Release 1 Cutover Runbook (Runbook)** is now available.

The purpose of this Runbook is to outline the activities that will take place over the Release 1 Go-Live weekend, targeted for Monday 20 April 2026. The objective of the Runbook is to ensure that Release 1 Go-Live is delivered safely, efficiently and effectively.

The Runbook also contains key information on:

- cutover scope, cutover event timing and communications plan
- governance, decision making and escalation arrangements
- cutover incident management and rollback considerations
- entering and exiting cutover
- cutover weekend rollback process, Release 1 Monday rollback timeline and an indicative communications plan for Monday market management
- cutover 'What If' scenarios
- hypercare arrangements, including post go-live support and communications.

Stakeholders are encouraged to review the Runbook to support awareness of the planned cutover activities and expectations for the go-live period.
