

Updates to APG and EIS messaging documentation for CHESS Release 1

We are pleased to advise that the updated **ASX Settlement Procedure Guidelines (APGs)** are now available. The latest version 4.0 of the APGs primarily reflects updates to incorporate CHESS Release 1 Clearing Service related changes, which will take effect at CHESS Release 1 Go-Live, planned for April 2026.

Updates to the APGs are required when CHESS Release 1 is live, as several EIS messages used by Approved Market Operators (AMOs) will be replaced by FIX messages outlined in the [AMO User Technical Documentation](#). Until CHESS Release 1 Go-Live, the previous version 3.9 of the APGs will remain in effect.

Additionally, the **CHESS External Interface Specifications (EIS)** documents have been updated to reflect the CHESS Release 1 AMO messaging changes. These updates include the decommissioning of a number of EIS messages that are no longer required. The EIS documents continue to provide detailed information on the protocol used to communicate with the CHESS system.
