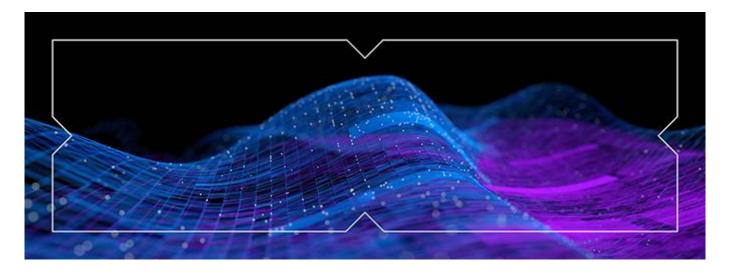

CHESS Release 2 Drop 2 User Technical Documentation is now available

ASX is pleased to announce that the **CHESS Release 2 User Technical Documentation** is now available for **Drop 2** of the CHESS Project.

The User Technical Documentation provides the specifications required by development teams to integrate with CHESS. It includes functional details of message flows, ISO message specifications and validation rules. The documentation also includes an introduction to Swift's MyStandards, the web platform used by ASX to publish ISO 20022 Usage Guidelines.

Drop 2 User Technical Documentation includes the following new features:

- trade registration, cancellation and netting
- settlement instructions
- batch settlement (excluding payments)
- pass-through investor data
- · release summaries and change logs.
